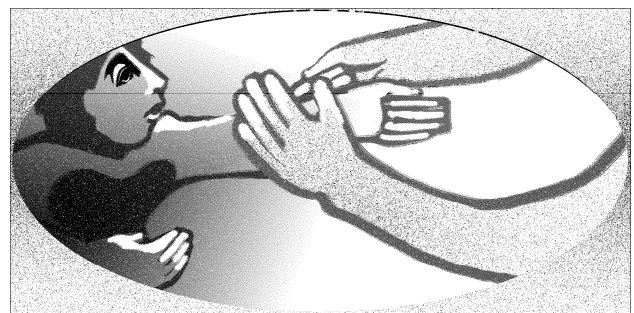
- What words of faith will I share with others this week?
