





To save them, God wishes to establish in the world devotion to my Immaculate Heart...I shall come to ask for the Communion of Reparation on the first Saturdays." Once you have completed five consecutive First Saturdays, continue to practice the devotion monthly for the sake of obtaining graces for the salvation of other souls. First Saturday Requirements: Go to Confession (may be 8 days before or after First Saturday), Receive Holy Communion. Pray 5 decades of the Rosary. Keep Our Lady Company.


