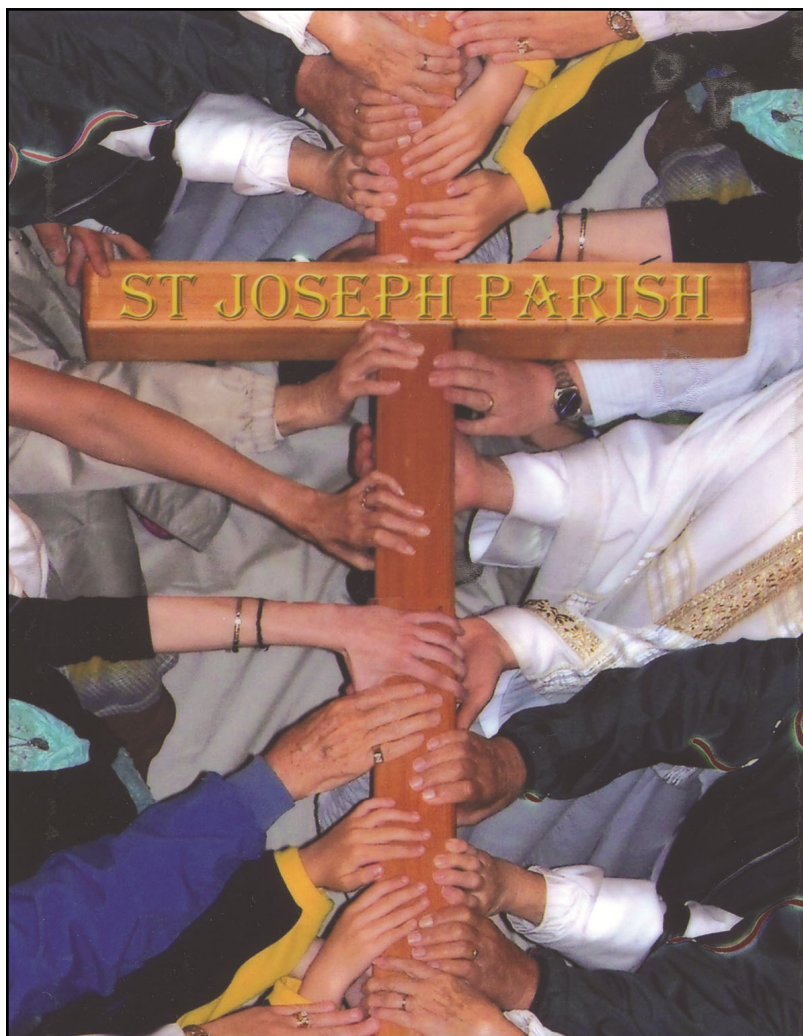

**4/8/2018**

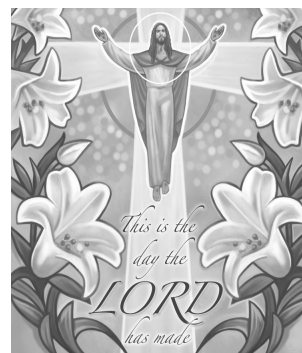
**First Reading** — The community of believers was of **one heart and mind** (Acts 4:32-35).
