


# World Day of Prayer for Vocations







## First Saturday Mass and Devotions In Reparation to The Immaculate Heart of Mary

Saturday, May 6, 2023, please join us at 8:00am Mass, followed by the Rosary and Fatima Prayers here at St. Joseph Church. We will provide pamphlets and rosaries. All are welcome.

#### **First Saturday Devotion**

One of the most important aspects of the Fatima message was Our Lady's request for the First Saturday devotion. In the July 13, 1917 apparition at Fatima, Our Lady said to the children, "you have seen hell where the souls of poor sinners go. To save them, God wishes to establish in the world devotion to my Immaculate Heart...I shall come to ask for the Communion of Reparation on the first Saturdays." Once you have completed five consecutive First Saturdays, continue to practice the devotion monthly for the sake of obtaining graces for the salvation of other souls. First Saturday Requirements: Go to Confession (may be 8 days before or after First Saturday), Receive Holy Communion. Pray 5 decades of the Rosary. Keep Our Lady Company.






