More information is to come so stayed tuned!

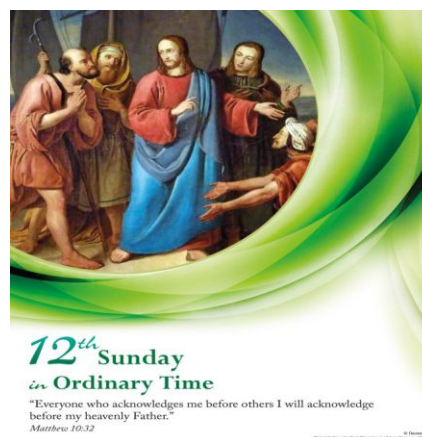
**Hospitality Sunday**

**First Saturday Devotion**

One of the most important aspects of the Fatima  
message was Our Lady’s request for the First Satur-  
day devotion. In the July 13, 1917 apparition at  
Fatima, Our Lady said to the children, “you have  
seen hell where the souls of poor sinners go. To  
save them, God wishes to establish in the world de-  
votion to my Immaculate Heart...I shall come to ask  
for the Communion of Reparation on the first Satur-  
days.” Once you have completed five consecutive  
First Saturdays, continue to practice the devotion  
monthly for the sake of obtaining graces for the sal-  
vation of other souls. **First Saturday Require-  
ments: Go to Confession** (may be 8 days before or  
after First Saturday), **Receive Holy Communion.**  
**Pray 5 decades of the Rosary. Keep Our Lady  
Company.**
