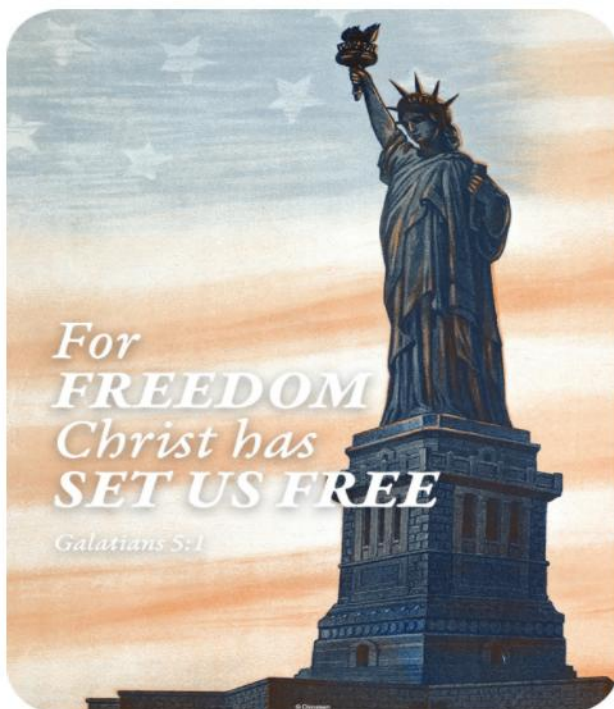
First Fridays at St. Joseph Parish






Catholic Services Appeal—2023


