



# Here I am, Lord!

"In the twilight of our lives, we will be judged based on how we loved." - St John of the Cross.

How do you treat others? Do you take for granted those closest to you? Do you open your eyes to strangers in need, or look the other way?

I know for myself I am extremely sensitive to criticism. It can be so hard to be around those who have hurt or offended me. Forgiveness is perhaps the most difficult of Christ's teachings to follow in my daily life. And yet, as a Christian, we will be known by our ability to forgive. Let us reflect on how we treat both strangers and those closest to us.

God, soften my heart. Set me free from the bondage of refusing to forgive and serve others.


